First launched in 2023, Bagos brand seeks to develop single varietals and more experimental wines, showing versatility of the grapes found in the wine-growing heritage of Lavradores de Feitoria's shareholders. Recovering traditional techniques and grape varieties or investing in differentiation from the vineyard to the glass, whichever makes sense.

Tasting Notes

Color: Bright, lemon straw colour.

Nose: Smooth and elegant, right from the start there are fresh notes of white pulp fruit and some floral notes, along with an apetrooled touch, very characteristic of this grape variety.

Mouth: Very fresh and mineral, it has fruit flavours such as pear and some pineapple, sustained by good acidity, which gives it excellent balance.

Very harmonious, it promises a good evolution.

Serving Temperature: 11.°C

Harmonization: To drink as an aperitif, solo, or at the table, with cold starters, lean fish, grilled fish, seafood, Asian dishes with spicy touches and some cheeses.
